

### HOW TO FOLLOW THE MONEY OF A HUMAN TRAFFICKING VICTIM

#1001: Sexual Exploitation (Victim)



Ellen's account has been flagged at her bank, after **the phone number** she has on file has been found in adult entertainment ads

Red Flag: Customer Details in Adult Ads



In the initial review of her account, it seems her address on file is **Calhoun St, Fort Worth, TX** (formerly known as Hells Half Acre, a red light district)...

Red Flag: Address in Red-light District





Finally, Ellen's account has shown a pattern of regular large **transfers to the same creditor**, leaving it almost empty every time

Red Flag: High Turnover Low Balance

Looking into the account further, Ellen has frequently received **deposits above \$500**, mostly coming in at night...

- Red Flag: Frequent incoming payments at night (2200-0600)
- Red Flag: Incoming payments at night and predominately from males

Each of these indicators alone may not be a concern, but together... you start to see the red flags. Now, bring in your reference data to build your case!

## Financial institutions must take action NOW.

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Regulation. FinCEN National Priorities, 6AMLD, FATF Recommendations

**10 million** increase in human trafficking in the last five years

Financial institutions have the data. They can stop the flow of illicit transactions

**\$150+** billion profits are generated by human trafficking crimes in a year

Human Trafficking is a significant money laundering predicate offence

Less than 1% of illicit gains from these crimes is ever recovered
